### **Install and Setting up Microsoft Teams on Mac**


This document explains how to install and setup Microsoft Teams if you don't already have it set up. You can also access Microsoft Teams via a Web app at <a href="https://products.office.com/en-au/microsoft-teams">https://products.office.com/en-au/microsoft-teams</a>.

#### Install MS Teams

If you don't have Microsoft Teams installed go to <a href="https://www.microsoft.com/en-au/microsoft-teams/download-app">https://www.microsoft.com/en-au/microsoft-teams/download-app</a> and download the MS Teams App. Once downloaded, run the installer to install MS Teams.

### Open and Signing into Teams


- 1. Navigate to your Applications folder and open Microsoft Teams or search for Microsoft Teams in the search bar.
- 2. When MS Teams starts for the first time, it will ask you to sign in. For this, you will need to sign in with your Schools Learnlink email address. If you don't know your LearnLink email address, simply enter in your <a href="mailto:FirstName.LastName@Schools.sa.edu.au">FirstName.LastName@Schools.sa.edu.au</a>. It is vital that you have entered the @Schools.sa.edu.au correctly. Then click Sign in.




